

# 2017-2018 Annual Fund Development Report

- **Funding Secured: \$4,950,237** in total grant funding
- **Active Grants, FY 17-18:** 6 grants & allocations awarded from federal and state agencies
- Hiring and onboarding of new Fund Development Portfolio Manager in October 2016
- Since 2011 Fund Development has **secured 20+ grant awards** worth more than **\$15.5M**.

## Awarded Grants

- ✓ **Smart Reentry Second Chance Grant: U.S. Dept. of Justice—\$999,965** over 3 years to build upon comprehensive strategies that reduce recidivism and create employment opportunities by expanding the America’s Job Center at Santa Rita Jail. Grant term: 10/1/2017 to 9/30/2020
- ✓ **CalFresh In A SNAP Grant: Cy Pres DRAM Settlement Fund—\$200,000** awarded over 2 years to implement IVR/VIVR technology enhancements and telephonic signatures for SNAP enrollment & recertification. Grant term: 5/1/2018 to 4/30/2020
- ✓ **Youth Homelessness: U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Children’s Bureau—\$1,340,000** to implement Year 3 and 4 of Alameda County Youth Transitions Partnership which provides intensive case management, skills coaching, case coordination, and supportive services for current and former foster youth at-risk of homelessness. Grant term: 9/30/2017 to 9/29/2019

## Awarded State Allocations

- ✓ **Housing & Disability Advocacy Program (HDAP): CA Department of Social Services—\$1,962,954** over 3 years to provide outreach, case management, disability advocacy and housing navigation and placement services to GA clients who are homeless. Grant term: 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2020
- ✓ **Emergency Child Care Bridge Program: CA Department of Social Services—\$422,318**, for 6 months to provide child care vouchers, navigation, and training for Resource & Referral (R&R) agencies. Grant term: 1/1/2018 to 6/30/2018
- ✓ **Healthy CalFresh Initiative: CA Department of Social Services—\$25,000** for “ReThink Your Drink Event” and “Get More From Your Farmers Market” campaigns during CalFresh Awareness Month. Grant term: 4/1/2018 to 6/30/2018

## Grants Administration

- ✓ Ongoing prospect research & grant vetting for all SSA departments: WBA, CFS, AAS, and WDB
